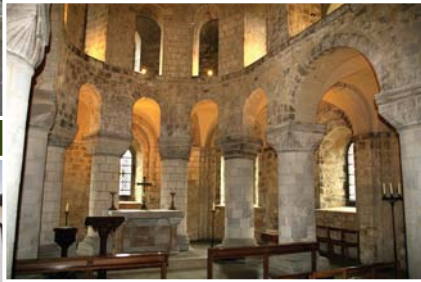

The projects have included the stone and timber repairs to the Byward Tower, the repair of the Yeoman Warders quarters, the conservation of the 12th Century St John Chapel, the conservation of the Bloody Tower, the investigation and repair of the Saint Peter ad Vincula Chapel and the design of a new conical lead roof to the 13th century Wakefield Tower.
