The Methodist Central Hall is a vast Edwardian building in the heart of Westminster which was the result of an architectural competition in 1905.

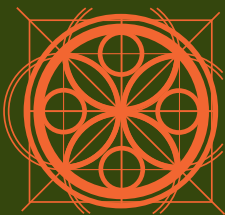
The refurbishment in 2005 brought the building into the 21st Century and regained some of the elegance of times past.
